INTRODUCTION



This is Volume IV of the *Operations of the Armée du Nord : 1815*, a reference of correspondence produced by Napoleon's last army, chronicling its organization and movements, until its defeat at Waterloo.

OPERATIONS OF THE *ARMÉE DU NORD* : 1815 THE ANALYSIS

This volume introduces the series and provides useful tools. It includes:

- Acknowledgments of the many individuals who made this work possible.
- The principles which guided transcription.
- Chart of persons found in the Correspondence, including those who are not well represented, though should be.
- A master Chronological Summary of all the transcribed correspondence.
- A master index of persons and places mentioned across all 5 volumes.
- Analysis of key topics, such as, the organization of the *Postes*, key maneuvers, and the crucial decisions few are aware of, though they determined the outcome of the campaign.

OPERATIONS OF THE *ARMÉE DU NORD* : 1815 : VOLUME I THE REGISTRIES

This volume includes some of the key correspondence of Napoleon and Davout, but focuses on Registries of key officers. Highlights include:

- Bertrand's personal registry for the *cent-jours* which includes many important orders and dictations of Napoleon.
- Soult's *Registre de Correspondance & Rapports à l'Empereur*
- Soult's *Mouvement des Troupes* - essentially the initial order book which ends where the famous *Registre du Major-général* begins.

This volume includes the key daily correspondence, from the moment Soult was appointed *major-général* of the *Armée du Nord*, until just before the concentration on the frontier began.

This volume includes the daily correspondence for the concentration of the *Armée du Nord*. The various corps were ordered to their initial staging area in preparation for the upcoming invasion.

This volume includes the daily correspondence during the week the *Armée du Nord* was given its final orders into position south of the Sambre, and then launched against the allies. It covers the battles of *Quatre-Bras* and *Ligny* and the pursuit the following day.
